Please note that this scholarship is open only to Tulane's currently enrolled Newcomb-Tulane undergraduate freshmen, sophomores, and/or juniors who have successfully completed a semester of full-time study at Tulane and have achieved a cumulative grade point average of 3.60 or higher.

If you are a currently enrolled Newcomb-Tulane undergraduate student who has successfully completed at least one full-time semester of Tulane enrollment and achieved a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.60 or higher, you are eligible to apply for the Stellar Tulane Academic Recognition Award (referred hereafter, as a Tulane STAR Award). Before you begin, please review the requirements and guidelines below. Be sure to note that the deadline for this form and all supporting documentation is April 1. Please understand that donor funding helps support this award.

REQUIREMENTS AND GUIDELINES			
	Complete and submit this STAR Award application with the required completed essay by April 1.		
	Only currently enrolled full-time Tulane freshmen, sophomores, and/or juniors who have completed at least one semester of full-time		
enrollment at Tulane and currently have a cumulative GPA of 3.60 or higher are eligible for consideration.			
	The STAR Award Selection Committee will give preference to students who have not been awarded any Tulane merit scholarship, although all		
who are eligible may apply.			
	STAR Award applicants are strongly encouraged to have filed for financial aid consideration during the current academic year, including the		
completion of the College Scholarship Service (CSS) Profile AND the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). While financial need is not a			
requirement to receive a STAR Award, preference is given to those applicants who have completed an application for financial assistance.			
	Late or incomplete applications cannot be considered.
