\***Commuters** are defined as those students who reside at home with parents and/or other family members.

\*\* **Miscellaneous** budgeted amounts represent costs for personal expenses; orientation fee; graduation fee; etc. Health insurance costs are not included since most students are covered under their parents' policy; however upon request the cost of health insurance can be added for those opting for coverage offered by the University.

\*\*\***Transportation** budgets for students whose permanent address is outside the New Orleans area, reflects the costs for the average advanced reservation airfare for two round trips from the student's home state to New Orleans each academic year and vary from \$400 to \$2,100. *On average, the median transportation budget allowance is \$1,000, and this amount is used for the NCAA Full Grant In-Aid calculation (attributable to over 65% of locations and 56% of full-time undergraduate students).*
