In addition, please note that **federal verification is required before any changes can be made to FAFSA information**, which means we would need to have on file an appropriate completed Verification Worksheet (available for download from our website), tax return information, and W-2 information, as well as any additional information requested.

IMPORTANT: If completing this Part I: Income section, a signed completed copy of the student's (and spouse's) 2024 federal income tax return MUST either accompany this submission or be on file with the Tulane University Financial Aid Office. Any reconsideration request based on a 2024 income decrease without the proper 2024 federal income tax return/s is incomplete and ineligible for review! Tulane recognizes that the filing deadline for a 2024 federal income tax return is scheduled to be April 15, 2025; however, since such completed tax returns are required for review of income loss, we encourage completion of 2024 federal tax returns as soon as possible so that a copy of the completed return/s may supplement this reconsideration request.
