This step-by-step checklist will help you and your family navigate the financial aid application process with confidence. (All forms for 2026–2027 will use your 2024 federal tax information.)

Initial Application Steps

☐ How Financial Aid Works

☐ Complete the 2026–2027 FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)

To be considered for federal aid (such as federal grants, work-study, and student loans):

- Visit https://studentaid.gov/
- Tulane's Federal School Code: 002029
- Use 2024 federal tax information
- You can submit the FAFSA before being admitted, but Tulane will review it only after admission
- □ **Complete the 2026–2027 CSS Profile** (required for Tulane institutional need scholarship)

 To be considered for Tulane institutional need scholarship, you must complete both the 2026–2027 FAFSA and the 2026–2027 CSS Profile.

- Tulane's CSS School Code: 6832
- Signed copies of parents' 2024 federal tax return (with all schedules), all business returns, and all 2024 W-2 forms should be uploaded directly to Tulane's secure portal:

☐ After getting your Gibson login from the Office of Admissions

- Check Gibson Portal Regularly

- Upload any requested documents securely
- Monitor your financial aid application status

After You Receive Your Financial Aid Offer

□ Review your award information in the Tulane Gibson Portal.

Follow the instructions to accept the terms and conditions and accept or decline each offer listed. https://financialaid.tulane.edu/my-aid

If You Plan to Borrow Student Loans

☐ Accept your loans in your Gibson Portal

You must accept your Subsidized and/or Unsubsidized Loan before Tulane can certify it. This must be done each year you wish to borrow.

- ☐ Complete First-Time Borrower Requirements (if applicable)
- 1. Master Promissory Note (MPN): https://studentaid.gov/mpn/
- 2. Entrance Counseling: https://studentaid.gov/entrance-counseling/

Your federal loans will not disburse until both the MPN and Entrance Counseling are completed.

☐ Considering a Private (Non-Federal) Loan?
