

2026/2027 Estimated Cost of Attendance: Full Time Undergraduate - First Year Students

What Is the Cost of Attendance?

The Cost of Attendance (COA) is an **estimated annual budget** that reflects the typical cost to attend the university for one academic year. It includes both:

- **Direct costs** – billed by the university
- **Indirect costs** – estimated expenses you may have while enrolled

Your actual bill will include **direct costs only**. Indirect costs are not billed by the university but are included to help families plan and to determine financial aid eligibility.

(Estimated) Annual Direct (Billed) Costs

These charges appear on your university bill.

Tuition	\$70,296	Full-time enrollment (12 credit hours and above per semester)
Mandatory Fees	\$4,838	Acad. Service, Health Ctr., Student Act., Rec Center
Housing	\$11,574	Assumed double occupancy in a communal-style residence hall.
Meal Plan	\$8,964	Assumed minimal required meal plan
Total Direct Costs	\$95,672	Estimated amount billed by the university

(Estimated) Annual Indirect Costs

These are typical expenses not billed by the university but necessary for attendance.

Books & Supplies	\$1,200	Average textbook and course material costs
Transportation	\$ varies	Local transportation and travel home
Miscellaneous	\$1,778	Additional living expenses
Loan Fees	\$58	Federal loan origination fees (if applicable)
Total Indirect Costs	\$3,036	Estimated out-of-pocket expenses

Total (Estimated) Annual Cost of Attendance

Total Direct Costs	\$95,672
Total Indirect Costs	\$3,036
TOTAL Cost of Attendance	\$98,708

This total represents the maximum amount of financial aid a student may receive from all sources.

Estimated travel costs vary based on a student's place of residence. The travel allowance is based on three trips per academic year—one trip to campus at the beginning of the semester, one round-trip during the semester, and one trip home at the end of the semester and reflects average reasonable costs.
