Independent students whose financial situation has changed from the time the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the CSS Profile form were filed may request review of the student's need for assistance. Significant changes, with accompanying loss of income, such as unemployment, death of a family member, change in marital status, and serious illness, can be considered with appropriate documentation.

The student and spouse (if any) are **required** to attach supporting documents to this form that verify the accuracy of the information provided. Please make sure the student's name is noted on the top of each document. Some examples of documents that may be used are: check stubs, legal divorce or separation papers, death certificates, and eligibility for workmen's compensation. In addition, please note that **federal verification is required before any changes can be made to FAFSA information**, which means we would need to have on file an appropriate completed Verification Worksheet (available for download from our website), tax return transcript information, and W-2 information, as well as any additional information requested.

The "Actual 2021 Income" column refers to items as they were reported on the 2023-2024 FAFSA and/or 2023-2024 CSS Profile. The "Actual 2022 Income" column refers to 2022 calendar year income and should reflect the change in your financial situation, and the income information that you provide must be an accurate representation of what is listed on your 2022 federal income tax return.

IMPORTANT: If completing this Part I: Income section, a signed completed copy of the student's (and spouse's) 2022 federal income tax return MUST either accompany this submission or be on file with the Tulane University Financial Aid Office. Any reconsideration request based on a 2022 income decrease without the proper 2022 federal income tax return/s is incomplete and ineligible for review! Tulane recognizes that the filing deadline for a 2022 federal income tax return is scheduled to be April 15, 2023; however, since such completed tax returns are required for review of income loss, we encourage completion of 2022 federal tax returns as soon as possible so that a copy of the completed return/s may supplement this reconsideration request.
