Tulane University fully acknowledges that the University signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement associated with the CRRSAA HEEF II and ARP HEERF III funds. Tulane University also offers assurance that the University has used, or intends to use, the Minimum Amount for Student Aid Portion funds received under the CRRSAA and ARP (a)(1) programs to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.
- 2. The total amount of HEERF II and III funds that Tulane University will receive or has received from the Department pursuant to the institution's Certification and Agreement [for] Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students for HEERF II Allocations for Public and Nonprofit Institutions under CRRSAA section 314(a)(1) Minimum Amount for Student Aid Portion (CFDA 84.425E Allocation) is \$2,795,095, and HEERF III Allocations for Public and Nonprofit Institutions under ARP section 2003(a)(1) Minimum Amount for Student Aid Portion (CFDA 84.425E Allocation) is \$7,315,697 (for a total of \$10,110,792).
